FINAL DEFAULT JUDGMENT

On March 20th, 2025, Plaintiff moved for Default Judgment after Defendant, Portillo Reyes Chavez, failed to answer in the above captioned cause. Plaintiff's motion was heard by submission on March 26, 2025. Plaintiff has appeared in person and through her attorney. Defendant, whose two representatives were duly served with citation and a copy of Plaintiff's original petition, has not appeared and answered.

On Submission, the Court determined is had jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties in this proceeding, and the citation and proof of service were on file for at least ten days before the motion was filed. After considering the pleadings, the papers on file in this case, and the evidence plaintiff presented on liability and damages, the Court grants Plaintiff's motion for default judgment.

The Court hereby RENDERS judgment for Plaintiff Carmen Acosta. Accordingly, the Court orders that Plaintiff recover the following from Defendant:

A. Actual damages in the amount of 2,325,100.00 which consists of:

a. 400,000.00 for mental anguish suffered in the past + future.

b. ~~for mental anguish suffered in the future~~

c. 400,000.00 for loss of consortium in the past and in the future.

d. 1,585,100.00 for economic damages, which consists of \$1,450,000.00 in lost wages + earning capacity, \$113,100.00 for lost contributions to household maintenance and \$22,000.00 for funeral expenses


B. Court Costs.

C. Postjudgment interest on all of the above at the rate of 7.5%, compounded annually,

from the date this judgment is rendered until all amounts are paid in full.
